Vaupel family research

Dear Larry,

I am pleased to report you on the new findings of the latest research into Vaupel and related families.

One of the issues was the question about the two youngest sons of Philipp Dölle and Elisabeth Vaupel. Philipp and Elisabeth were born in Reichensachsen and got married there 1883. I studied the baptismal, marriage, confirmation, and death records of Reichensachsen, but there are no children in addition to the three we have found in the previous round of research: Anna Dorothea, Anna Catharina Margaretha, and Georg Ludwig.

Anna Catharina Margaretha died at the age of three. Anna Dorothea and Georg Ludwig got confirmed in the church of Reichensachsen 1898 and 1903, respectively. This proves, that the family still was living in Reichensachsen, which means, if there were additional children they would be recorded in the churchbooks of Reichensachsen.

Anna Dorothea got married to Heinrich Bauer 1903. The couple lived in Rommerode, where Heinrich was born 1876. He died in Rommerode 1924.

So according to the records, Philipp Dölle and Elisabeth Vaupel did not have "two youngest sons". Maybe those two are close relatives instead. If you like, send me a scan or copy of the letters that led to the knowledge on the two boys for a review.

Another issue was Krug families. First of all, among your ancestors there is Anna Christina Krug, who got married to Johann Heinrich Vaupel 1822. Then there is "John M. Krug", who also emigrated to lowa. I did further research into both families, but it turned out, that they are not closely related.

"John M." was born and baptized by the name of Johannes Krug in Reichensachsen 1864. His parents are Bernhard Krug and Catharina Elisabeth Lohr. Bernhard made a living as a factory-worker and daylaborer. He died in Reichensachsen 1876, at the

age of 37 years only. With his wife he generated four children, which of son George died at the age of 16 in 1881. From then there was no mention anymore of this family in Reichensachsen records.

I traced this Krug family a few generations. It turned out that all the time they lived in Reichensachsen. Bernhard was born in Reichensachsen 1838 as a son to Reinhard Krug and Martha Elisabeth Beck. Reinhard is a son of Johann Martin Krug and Marie Sabine Albrecht. Johann Martin was born in Reichensachsen 1770 as a son to Johann Werner Krug. The latter is a son of Johannes Krug.

Now let us turn to your ancestor Anna Christina Krug. Her family is not from Reichensachsen. She was born in Langenhain on Jan 3, 1795. Her parents are Johannes Krug and Dorothea Maria Sandrock, who besides Anna Christina had one more child only. Neither Johannes nor Dorothea Maria were natives of Langenhain, but born in Oetmannshausen. Johannes is a son of Johannes Krug, who came from Eschwege, and Anna Barbara Schweitzer. Dorothea Maria was born as the illegitimate daughter of Christoph Sandrock and Martha Elisabeth Barthel. Her parents never got married to eachother.

Now let us have a close look on the various Vaupel branches in Reichensachsen. This research was of difficult nature because of the limited information that the early vital records provide, while at the same time, there is number of Vaupel families in the village, with several individuals bearing identical given and last names. So it took some effort to sort them out and establish the right connections.

Your ancestor Johann Henrich Vaupel, who got married to Anna Margaretha Burckhard on May 17, 1735, as we found out in the previous research, was baptized in Reichensachsen by the name of George Henrich Vaupel. His parents are Conrad Vaupel, usually called Conrad, but also called Curt, which is a variation of Conrad, and Catharina Külmar. The baptismal record is the only record stating his given names as George Henrich, already his confirmation record of 1716 lists him as Johann Henrich.

As you know, your ancestor Carl Christoph Vaupel's (b.1864) maternal grandmother is Anna Elisabeth Vaupel, so the name of Vaupel appears on both his paternal and maternal sides. I traced Anna Elisabeth's ancestry to find out if her lineage connects to Johann Henrich Vaupel.

Anna Elisabeth's father is Johann George Vaupel, who made a living as a linenweaver. He was married twice and generated a total of 10 children, which of seven died without having created own families. Anna Elisabeth was Johann George's youngest child. She had two half-sisters that got married in Reichensachsen.

Johann George Vaupel was born in Reichensachsen 1742. His parents are Johannes Vaupel and Anna Barbara Wagner. Johannes was a shepherd in Reichensachsen. He was born there 1702 as a son to above-mentioned Conrad Vaupel and Anna Catharina Külmar, in other words, Johannes and Johann Henrich are brothers.

Their father Conrad made a living as a master shepherd.

Another issue was Johann Peter Vaupel, who got married to Catharina Elisabeth, daughter of Johann Peter Vaupel and Anna Elisabeth Kaufmann. I also traced him and tried to find the common ancestor. Johann Peter was born in Reichensachsen 1796 as a son to Johann Philipp Vaupel and Anna Gertrud Fey. Their wedding took place in Reichensachsen 1789. Johann Philipp and Anna Gertrude generated five children. After her death in 1814, he got remarried and had another daughter. Johann Philipp was a master shepherd. He was born 1765 as a son to Johann Jacob Vaupel.

Johann Jacob was born 1737 as a son to Christian Vaupel. Christian was born in Reichensachsen 1712 as a son to Johann Conrad Vaupel, and the latter was born 1687, as a son to Johannes Vaupel, who was born 1653.

Johannes' father is Georg Vaupel, who is the first Vaupel we can find in Reichensachsen and obviously he is the one, that all Reichensachsen Vaupels descend from.

Your ancestor Conrad Vaupel was born in Reichensachsen 1679 as a son to Nicolaus Vaupel, who like many in the family was a shepherd. Nicolaus' parents are Georg Vaupel and Eulalia Wissenborn. They got married in Reichensachsen 1639. We are very fortunate that their marriage record is available, because records of Reichensachsen start right in the year of 1639.

Georg died in Reichensachsen on Apr 14, 1673 at a stated age of 76 ½ years, giving his birthdate as 1596.

Members of family Külmar can be found in your ancestry several times, too. There is Anna Catharina Külmar, who was born 1681, and Johann Jacob Külmar, who was born 1684.

I tried to find out, if they have a common ancestor. This turned out to be even more complicated than sorting the Vaupels out, because in the 1670ies and 1680ies, there were three families in Reichensachsen, whose heads all bore the name of Johannes Külmar. All three of whom were generating children at the same time, and the recorder of the baptismal records does not give many clues to distinguish the three families. So I combined every bit of information that was available to establish these families as good as poosible, though several links remain uncertain.

However, it seems pretty certain, that both of your ancestors Anna Catharina Külmar and Johann Jacob Külmar were siblings and children to Johannes Külmar and Gerdrut. When Anna Catharina got married 1702 her father is given as no more alive, while the other Johannes Külmar, who could potentially be her father, died 1715 only.

There is another Johann Jacob Külmar, born to a Johannes Küllmar on Feb 19, 1685. His father was still alive when the child was confirmed, which means, that Johann Jacob Külmar, who was born on Nov 12, 1684, must be a son to Johannes and Gerdrut.

The marriage of Johannes and Gerdrut is not recorded in Reichensachsen.

Johannes was born in Reichensachsen 1648 as a son to Caspar Külmar and Maria Margaretha. They had a number of surviving children, among them two sons by the name of Johannes. The third Johannes Külmar, who was living at the time, probably

was a cousin. I have added information on the names and dates of his family in the attachments as well.

I thought another interesting issue was the question, whether members of your ancestral families fought in the American War of Independence. To find out, I reserached the so-called HETRINA file, which is retained at the Hessian state archives.

This is what I found out:

- A Jacob Vaupel from Reichensachsen, born 1750-1752, fought as a private in the Prince Successor regiment. He was on leave 1775, became a prisoner of war 1783, and deserted 1783. Most likely, this Jacob Vaupel is identical to Johann Jacob Vaupel, who was born in Reichensachsen on Nov 12, 1751, and who is the youngest brother of your ancestor Johann Henrich Vaupel (b.1735).
- A Johannes Vaupel from Reichensachsen, born 1750-1751, in the rank of a captain d'armes, also fought in the Prince Successor regiment, and deserted 1783.
- In the same regiment there were Kaspar Vaupel from Reichensachsen (b.1752/53), who deserted 1783, and Reinhard Vaupel from Reichensachsen (b.1760/61).

Several members of Külmar family from Reichensachsen, by the names of Nikolaus, Henrich, Johann Henrich, and Georg, fought in America, too, but as far as I could see, no sibling of your ancestors.

Descendancy report - Georg VAUPEL

First Generation

1. Georg VAUPEL was born¹ in 1596. He was buried² on 14 Apr 1673 in Reichensachsen.

ALSO-CALLED: Jörg; George

SPELLINGS-LAST-NAME: Vaupel, Vaupell

BIOGRAPHY: In the register of souls for Reichensachsen, dating Dec 30, 1652, there is recorded:

"Georg Vaupel and Eila, 4 children".

STATED-AGE-AT-DEATH: 76 1/2 years

RESEARCH-NOTES: In the register of souls of Reichensachsen 1647 he is not recorded.

Churchbooks of Reichensachsen start 1639.

There got married in Reichensachsen on Jan 22, 1652: Johann Philipp Bartel from France to Catharina Vaupel. She was buried in Reichensachsen on Apr 20, 1698, at a stated age of 85 years, giving her birthdate as abt. 1613. She could be Georg Vaupel's sister.

The baptisms of his children Nicolaus, Wilhelm, and Elisabetha are not recorded in the churchbooks of Reichensachsen, which suggests that for several years in the 1640ies Georg and his family did not stay in Reichensachsen.

Georg married³ Eulalia WISSENBORN daughter of Hans WISSENBORN on 4 Nov 1639 in Reichensachsen. Eulalia was born⁴ in 1618. She was buried⁵ on 17 Aug 1705 in Reichensachsen.

ALSO-CALLED: Eila

STATED-AGE-AT-DEATH: 87 years 24 weeks

Georg and Eulalia had the following children:

2 F i. Catharina VAUPEL was christened⁶ in 1639 in Reichensachsen.

Catharina was confirmed⁷ on 26 Mar 1654 in Reichensachsen.

GODPARENTS/SPONSORS: Curt Scheffer's wife

- + 3 M ii. Nicolaus VAUPEL was born about 1644. He was buried on 24 Mar 1693.

RESEARCH-NOTES: There is no documented evidence that Orthia and Johannes are children to Nicolaus.

Nicolaus married Elisabetha. Elisabetha was born¹³ in 1635. She was buried¹⁴ on 25 Jan 1706 in Reichensachsen.

STATED-AGE-AT-DEATH: 70 years, 6 weeks

Nicolaus and Elisabetha had the following children:

7 F i. Orthia VAUPEL was born¹⁵ about 1661.

Orthia was confirmed¹⁶ on 19 Apr 1674 in Reichensachsen.

RESEARCH-NOTES: Her baptism is not recorded in the churchbooks of Reichensachsen.

- + 34 M i. Christian VAUPEL was christened on 14 Oct 1712. He died on 9 Jan 1780.
 - 35 M ii. Justus VAUPEL was christened⁸² in Mar 1715. He was buried⁸³ on 23 Apr 1715 in Reichensachsen.

RESEARCH-NOTES: His baptism is not recorded in the churchbooks of Reichensachsen.

It is uncertain, if he is a son of Johann Conrad Vaupel (b.1687) and Anna Schmidt , as shown in this chart, or son of Conrad Vaupel (b.1679) and Anna Catharina Külmar.




